



New Single Song Release: "A Mother's Love ONCE MORE"

This new song explains that ... "A Mother's Love" ... will be felt ... "ONCE MORE."

His words were written on February 4th 1985 while driving 317 miles on California freeways from Newport Beach to Merced, ... a pen in one hand with the steering wheel in the other ... for seven hours. Forty years later those lyrics have not changed ... and never will. They glow & grow again in this new song.

The day before that long drive, Del had sailed his boat back to the dock in Newport Beach, when he saw his brother standing there on the dock with a sad face. What he heard next, was that their Mother had passed that morning from a sudden stroke ... 13 days before her 57th birthday ... while getting ready for church ... to celebrate their Wedding Anniversary. A sad Sunday, it was.

The next day, Del called his office, explained the situation, canceled meetings, and started his seven-hour drive to Merced to be with his Dad, who had witnessed everything. During that 1985 drive he wrote the lyrics for his Mother's Eulogy ... and those same lyrics are now in this new song. Three hours before her

services ... because he knew he would be too emotional to read the heart-felt words at her services ... he went to a Merced radio station and recorded his Eulogy with background music. That year he was President of the largest CableTV company in Arizona, serving Phoenix, Mesa, Tempe, Chandler, and many other cities.

Three years later, Del wrote the music for "Mother's Song" and narrated the same lyrics over that music and released the recording as ... "Mother's Song – The Eulogy." Using the lyrics he had written on his 1985 drive.

That Mother's Day in 1988, his new "Mother's Song" recording went nationwide, played on 3000+ radio stations, was the most requested song on the nation's largest audience radio station in New York City, and became the fastest selling product on Home Shopping Network, as reported by its Board Member.

"Mother's Song" successes continued into 1989 and 1990 during the Mothers' Day broadcast seasons.

What's unique about the Del Henry story is that he had a "Hit Song" before releasing an Album. He has been a Voting Member of The Grammys for 32 years and honored with Membership in two of their Special Wings.

He now has two Albums on more than 100 Digital Music websites.

The albums are entitled ... "Mother's Day Every Day" and "Dream Awhile" ... with 21 songs. He composed the songs, the lyrics and the music. Search the **OnLine Music Sites** using: **del henry, liszenup houzeband**

In 2010, Del began writing new music for his 1985 lyrics. And continued to write and compose his new music in 2013 and on into 2024. Early in 2025 he began recording tracks for "A Mother's Love ONCE MORE."

These Recording Musicians are some of the Best in the World: Peggy Duquesnel on piano & keyboards, MB Gordy on drums, Kevin Axt on bass, Dave Murdy on guitars, Tony Guerrero on Flugelhorn, with vocalist Nicolette Homan, and Studio & Mixing Engineering by Lucas Fehring.

What Stellar credits!! Multi-Grammy Winners, Peggy has released 16 albums, some have recorded on hundreds of albums, several have been featured on Tours and with Solo's.

They are Definitely within the "A-Cats" of the recording industry. AKA - The Best of the Best.

Del's new release is entitled ... **"A Mother's Love ONCE MORE"** and is being released for Mother's Day 2025.

The song includes these lyrics: "My Life became because of You. You encouraged and inspired. You shaped our thoughts and molded us ... and never seemed to tire." And the words also say: "If Only We could hold you just Once More before you go. If Only We could tell you, just Once More, We Love You So."

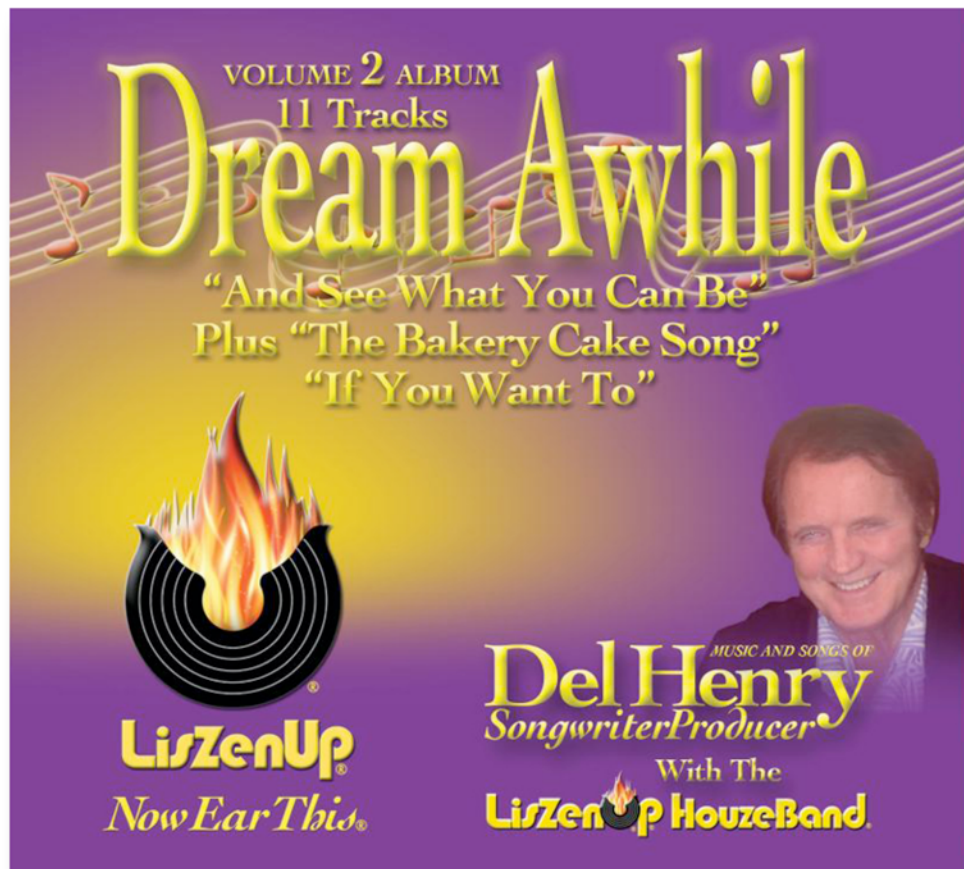
Written 40 years ago for his Mother's Eulogy at her services, this Song's lyrics will never, ever, change.

As of February 2025, his Mother has been gone for 40 years ... but She's not forgotten ... And never will be.

"I really owe a deep gratitude to my parents. They couldn't give me material gifts, but they gave me the confidence to follow my dreams, whether in music, sports, my education or business," Henry said. "This song is dedicated to my mother, who always believed in me and my dreams, and gave me the confidence to follow them." When he started on Scholarship at UC Berkeley, neither of his parents had graduated from High School. His Mother later was Valedictorian of her Adult-Ed High School graduating class and she set new records there. Their son graduated at UC Berkeley.

He adds this Release ... **"A Mother's Love ONCE MORE"** ... to his songs honoring his Parents.
